## 2 CHARLESTON FARMERS MARKET Charleston, South Carolina

Since the late 1980s, the Charleston Farmers Market's mid-April opening has signaled the arrival of warmer weather and fresh, locally sourced goods to the devoted patrons who wait all winter to spend their Saturdays strolling through its tent-lined lanes. Featuring over 100 farmers, artisans, and food vendors, this weekly market in historic downtown Charleston is definitely worth the drive. The market's proceeds go toward supporting the area's farmers and their families in hopes of making fresh, healthy food available to everyone.
